Hearing before Administrative Law Judge Dail Stiles on October 30, 2003, in Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas.

A hearing was held on October 30, 2003, to determine whether a Joint Petition Order entered June 24, 2002, had been enforced.

The claimant contends that some representations had been made at the joint petition hearing on June 24, 2002, relative to the payment of some medical bills, and that those representations had gone unfulfilled and that certain medical bills remained unpaid.

The respondents contend that medical bills set forth in an exhibit introduced at the joint petition hearing on June 24, 2002, were paid.

At the hearing, it was ascertained that there are two medical bills which remain outstanding. One was in the amount of \$501.00 and one in the amount of \$120.00.

The respondents at hearing examined the bills and determined that they were related to the claimant's compensable injury, and represented to the claimant and to the Commission that those bills would be placed in line for payment.

FINDING OF FACT

The claimant is entitled to have two medical bills paid by the respondents. One in the amount of \$501.00 and the other in the amount of \$120.00, subject to Rule 30 audit.

AWARD

Respondents are directed to pay medical bills in the amount of \$621.00.
