ORDER

This case comes on for review before the
Commission on claimant's motion for an extension of time to
file his brief to the Full Commission.

In an opinion filed August 19, 2003, the
Administrative Law Judge denied this claim on a finding that
claimant was not an employee of the uninsured employer.
Claimant filed a timely notice of appeal and his brief was
due October 17, 2003. On October 16, 2003, claimant filed
a motion for a 30-day extension to file the brief. By Order
dated November 3, 2003, the Full Commission granted
claimant's motion. Thereafter, claimant's brief became due
November 21, 2003. On November 14, 2003, claimant filed the

present motion for another 30-day extension of the briefing schedule.

After our consideration of claimant's motion, respondents' agreement thereto, and all other matters properly before the Commission, we find that claimant's motion should be granted. However, additional extensions of time to file claimant's brief will not be granted.

Accordingly, we find that claimant's motion for an extension of time to file his brief should be, and hereby is, granted. Additionally, the Clerk of the Commission is directed to set another briefing schedule forthwith.
