OPINION AND ORDER

The claimant appeals from a decision of the  
Administrative Law Judge filed April 17, 2003. The  
Administrative Law Judge entered the following findings of  
fact and conclusions of law:

1. The Workers' Compensation Commission has jurisdiction of this claim in which the relationship of employee-employer-carrier existed among the parties on December 12, 2000, at which time the claimant sustained a fall resulting in abrasions to the head, which arose out of and in the course of his employment.

2. The claimant has failed to prove by a preponderance of the credible evidence of record that there is any causal connection between the compensable fall and his complaints of headaches, neck pain, shoulder pain, and syncope episodes. There is no objective medical evidence to establish any physical bodily harm requiring medical treatment or producing disability.
3. The respondents have paid all appropriate benefits.

We have carefully conducted a de novo review of the entire record herein, and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence, correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings of fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct, and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission.

Thus, we affirm and adopt the decision of the Administrative Law Judge, including all findings and conclusions therein, as the decision of the Full Commission on appeal.
