ORDER

In an opinion not designated for publication, the
Arkansas Court of Appeals has affirmed the Full Commission's
finding that the claimant sustained a compensable injury.
See, Healthsouth Rehabilitation Hospital et al. v. Maxine
Reese, CA03-256 (Ark. App. October 1, 2003). However, the
Court of Appeals has reversed and remanded the Full
Commission's award of temporary total disability
compensation from February 22, 2001 through August 1, 2001.

The Full Commission therefore remands this case to the
administrative law judge. We direct the administrative law

judge to conduct those proceedings necessary to adjudicate whether the claimant is entitled to temporary total disability compensation.
