OPINION AND ORDER

The claimant appeals from a decision of the Administrative Law Judge filed September 17, 2003.

The Administrative Law Judge entered the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. The Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission has jurisdiction of this claim;
2. On February 20, 2003, the relationship of the employee-employer-carrier existed between the parties.
3. The claimant is entitled to a compensation rate of \$369.00 for temporary total

disability and \$277.00 for permanent partial disability .

4. The claimant has failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence that he sustained a work related injury while working for the respondent on February 20, 2003.

We have carefully conducted a de novo review of the entire record herein and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence, correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings of fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission.

Thus, we affirm and adopt the decision of the Administrative Law Judge, including all findings and conclusions therein, as the decision of the Full Commission on appeal.
