OPINION AND ORDER

This case comes on for review by the Full
Commission on appeal by claimant from an opinion filed
herein by an Administrative Law Judge on March 29, 2004.

The Administrative Law Judge entered the following
findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. The stipulations agreed to by the parties at the pre-hearing conference conducted on December 22, 2003, and contained in a pre-hearing order filed that same date, are hereby accepted as fact.

2. Claimant has failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence that she suffered a compensable injury in the form of bilateral carpal tunnel syndrome while employed by respondent.

In this case, we have reviewed the record de novo, weighing the evidence impartially and without giving the benefit of the doubt to either party. Ark. Code Ann. § 11-9-704(c) and Fowler v. McHenry, 22 Ark. App. 196, 737 S.W.2d 663 (1987). It is our opinion that the decision of the Administrative Law Judge is correct and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings of fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct, and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission. Accordingly, we affirm and adopt the decision of the Administrative Law Judge filed March 29, 2004, and this claim is denied and dismissed.
