ORDER

Presently before the Commission is claimant's motion to hold his appeal in abeyance. After consideration of claimant's motion, as well as all other matters properly before the Commission, we find that the claimant's motion should be and hereby is denied.

Claimant filed a timely notice of appeal from an order entered by the Administrative Law Judge on February 28, 2005. In that order, the Administrative Law Judge denied

relief because the injury complained of by claimant was not causally connected to the injury of March 26, 2003.

Claimant filed an amended claim form (F409572) for the January 19, 2004 injury which has resulted in a new hearing scheduled for February, 2006. We fail to see good cause shown to hold the appeal in this case (F305296) in abeyance pending the outcome of the other case. Thus, we must deny the claimant's motion for abeyance of this appeal. The other case (F409572) is not pending before this Commission at present and has not even been heard by the Administrative Law Judge.

We find the claimant has not established good cause to hold in abeyance the appeal in the present case. Thus, we deny this motion.
