ORDER

The Arkansas Supreme Court has reversed the Commission in the above-styled matter and has remanded for proceedings consistent with the Court's opinion. Moncus v. Billingsley, 05-1353 (May 18, 2006). The Court has held, that the claimant's death occurred while he was performing employment services and reversed and remanded for a consideration of benefits.

The Full Commission therefore remands this case to an administrative law judge for additional proceedings. The administrative law judge shall conduct those proceedings
