ORDER

This matter is currently before the Full Commission on remand from the Arkansas Court of Appeals. In an opinion delivered May 9, 2007, the Arkansas Court of Appeals affirmed in part and reversed in part the decision of the Full Commission, which had affirmed and adopted the decision of the Administrative Law Judge. The Arkansas Court of Appeals affirmed the finding that the claimant failed to prove entitlement to additional temporary total disability benefits. However, the Court reversed the finding that the claimant failed to prove entitlement to additional medical treatment by Dr. Counts for depression secondary to pain and remanded this case to the Full

Commission for proceedings consistent with their opinion. Accordingly, we hereby remand this case to the Administrative Law Judge for additional findings consistent with the May 9, 2007, opinion of the Arkansas Court of Appeals.
