ORDER

This claim is presently before the Commission on remand from the Court of Appeals. In a decision delivered November 5, 2008, the Court of Appeals reversed the decision of the Full Commission and remanded for an award of benefits. Accordingly, we hereby find that the periodic evaluations as recommended by the claimant's treating physicians for a medically foreseeable condition related to her compensable injury constitute reasonably necessary medical treatment. Therefore, we find that the claimant has proven by a preponderance of the evidence that the recommended treatment for follow-up evaluations to monitor

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her compensable injury is reasonable and necessary medical treatment to which she is entitled.

All accrued benefits shall be paid in a lump sum without discount and with interest thereon at the lawful rate from the date of the Administrative Law Judge's decision in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 11-9-809 (Repl. 2002). For prevailing on this appeal before the Full Commission, claimant's attorney is hereby awarded an additional attorney's fee in the amount of \$500.00 in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 11-9-715(b)(2) (Repl. 2002).
