**OPINION AND ORDER**

The respondents appeal from a decision of the Administrative Law Judge filed September 14, 2007.

The Administrative Law Judge entered the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. The Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission has jurisdiction over this claim.
2. The stipulations set forth above are reasonable and are hereby accepted.

3. Claimant has proven by a preponderance of the evidence that he sustained a compensable injury to his low back on September 29, 2006.

4. Claimant has proven by a preponderance of the evidence that he is entitled to temporary total disability benefits from September 29, 2006 to December 13, 2006.

5. Claimant has proven by a preponderance of the evidence that he is entitled to reasonable and necessary medical treatment from September 29, 2006 to December 13, 2006.

6. Claimant's attorney is entitled to a controverted attorney's fee on all indemnity benefits awarded to Claimant, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 11-9-715.

We have carefully conducted a de novo review of the entire record herein and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence, correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings of fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission.

Thus, we affirm and adopt the decision of the

Administrative Law Judge, including all findings and conclusions therein, as the decision of the Full Commission on appeal.
