OPINION AND ORDER

The Arkansas Court of Appeals has reversed the Full Commission's decision in the above-styled matter and has remanded for an award of benefits. *Curtis v. Big Lots*, CA08-691 (April 15, 2009). In accordance with the remand from the Court of Appeals, the Full Commission affirms the administrative law judge's finding that the claimant proved she was entitled to additional medical treatment for her compensable injury. For prevailing on appeal to the Full

Commission, the claimant's attorney is entitled to a fee of five hundred dollars (\$500), pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-715(b) (Repl. 2002).
