OPINION AND ORDER

Claimant appeals an opinion and order of the
Administrative Law Judge filed August 19, 2009. In said
order, the Administrative Law Judge made the following
findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. The Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission has jurisdiction over these claims.
2. The stipulations set forth above are reasonable and are hereby accepted.
3. Claimant has not proven by a preponderance of the evidence that he is entitled to additional treatment by Dr. Zach Mason.

4. Claimant may return to Drs. Edward Saer or Charles Pearce for additional treatment.

We have carefully conducted a de novo review of the entire record herein and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence, correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings of fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission.

Therefore we affirm and adopt the August 19, 2009 decision of the Administrative Law Judge, including all findings and conclusions therein, as the decision of the Full Commission on appeal.
