Decision of Administrative Law Judge: Reversed.

ORDER

In the above-styled matter, the Arkansas Court of Appeals has reversed the opinion of the Commission and has remanded for an award of benefits. *Dick v. Conley Transport*, CA09-457 (Nov. 18, 2009).

Therefore, the Full Commission reverses the administrative law judge's denial of additional benefits. In accordance with the mandate from the Court of Appeals, the Full Commission finds that the claimant proved she was entitled to an MRI as recommended by Dr. Greenberg. We find that the claimant proved she was

entitled to temporary total disability benefits from May 8, 2007 to a date yet to be determined.

The claimant's attorney is entitled to fees for legal services pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-715(Repl. 1996). For prevailing on appeal to the Full Commission, the claimant's attorney is entitled to an additional fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-715(b) (Repl. 1996).
