NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

The Full Commission finds that a clerical error exists in our opinion filed September 13, 2010. Finding of Fact No. 9, states, "The claimant has proven by a preponderance of the evidence that she is entitled to either an ultrasound and/or a venous Doppler test of her right lower extremity." Finding of

Fact No. 9 should state, "Claimant has not proven by a preponderance of the evidence that she is entitled to either an ultrasound and/or a venous Doppler test of her right lower extremity."

In accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-713(d) (Repl. 2002), the Full Commission modifies the September 13, 2010 opinion to find that the claimant did not prove she was entitled to an ultrasound or venous Doppler test of the claimant's right lower extremity. The September 13, 2010 Full Commission opinion is not otherwise modified.
