OPINION AND ORDER

Claimant appeals from a decision of the Administrative Law Judge filed January 6, 2010.

The Administrative Law Judge entered the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. There was an employer-employee relationship on October 5, 2007.
2. The claimant's average weekly wage is \$352.
3. The claimant has failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence that she sustained a compensable injury supported by objective findings.

We have carefully conducted a de novo review of the entire record herein and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence, correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings of fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission.

Thus, we affirm and adopt the decision of the Administrative Law Judge, including all findings and conclusions therein, as the decision of the Full Commission on appeal.
