ORDER

This matter is currently before the Commission on Respondent No. 1's Motion to Stay Proceedings Pending Outcome of Appeal and Motion to Expedite the Appeals Process. After consideration of respondent No. 1's motion, claimant's response thereto and all other matters properly before this Commission, we find that respondent No. 1's Motion to Stay Proceedings Pending

Outcome of Appeal and Motion to Expedite the Appeals Process is moot. Respondents move the Commission to stay the proceedings before the Administrative Law Judge in claim number G001584. However, as the hearing scheduled for July 6, 2005, has already taken place, claimant's motion to stay the proceedings is moot.
