ORDER

This matter is currently before the Full
Workers' Compensation Commission on remand from the
Arkansas Court of Appeals. In an Opinion dated December
2, 2009, the Arkansas Court of Appeals remanded this
case to the Full Commission with instructions to
consider the claimant's request for attorney's fees.
After a de novo review of the record and pursuant to the
Court of Appeals mandate, the Full Commission finds that
the claimant is entitled to an award of 25% of indemnity
benefits awarded to the claimant to be paid pursuant to
Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-715(a)(2)(B)(i).

All accrued benefits shall be paid in a lump sum without discount and with interest thereon at the lawful rate from the date of the Administrative Law Judge's decision in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-809 (Repl. 2002).
