ORDER

The respondents in the above-styled matter have
filed a motion for reconsideration.

In an opinion filed February 25, 2010, an
administrative law judge found that the claimant did not
prove he was entitled to additional temporary total
disability benefits. The administrative law judge
found, however, that the claimant proved he was entitled
to an anatomical impairment rating and wage-loss
disability benefits. The Full Commission affirmed and

adopted the administrative law judge's decision in an opinion filed August 13, 2010.

The Full Commission sees no compelling reason to reconsider our August 13, 2010 opinion. We note that both parties have appealed to the Arkansas Court of Appeals. The Full Commission denies the respondents' motion.

I must respectfully dissent. For those reasons set forth in my original dissent, I find that the claimant resigned from his employment. Having found that the claimant resigned from his employment, the majority decision is in conflict with our recent holding in Cantrell v. Temple Inland, Full Commission Opinion filed June 3, 2010 (F904606). Therefore, I would grant Respondents' Motion for Reconsideration.
