ORDER

Respondent No. 2 in the above-styled matter has filed a
motion for reconsideration. The Full Commission grants the
motion.

An administrative law judge filed an opinion on December 13, 2010 and found, among other things, that Respondent No. 1 and Respondent No. 2 were liable to the claimant for appropriate workers' compensation benefits. Respondent No. 2 appealed to the Full Commission. The Full Commission affirmed and adopted the administrative law judge's decision in an opinion filed May 19, 2011. The Full Commission awarded accrued benefits in a lump sum in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-809(Repl. 2002), as well as fees for legal services in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-715(Repl. 2002).

Respondent No. 2 states in its motion that there is no accrued and unpaid compensation to be paid in lump sum and that fees for legal services are not owed. The claimant has been served with a copy of the motion. The Commission has also notified the claimant of Respondent No. 2's motion. The claimant has not filed an objection. Respondent No. 1 informs the Commission that it agrees with the motion.

The Full Commission therefore grants Respondent No. 2's motion for reconsideration. Based on the pleadings and the record currently before us, the Full Commission finds that

there shall be no award of interest upon compensation and no award of fees for legal services.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
