OPINION AND ORDER

Claimant appeals from a decision of the Administrative Law Judge filed June 24, 2011.

The Administrative Law Judge entered the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. The Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission has jurisdiction over this claim.
2. The stipulations agreed to by the parties are hereby accepted as fact.
3. The claimant has failed to prove, by a preponderance of the evidence, that she sustained any work-related injuries arising out of and during the course of her employment with Days Inn

Hamilton Resort on June 26, 2010, which can be established by medical evidence supported by objective findings.

4. At the May 6, 2011, hearing, the claimant, for the first time, raised an issue concerning possible wrongful termination which is, by necessity, specifically reserved. (Tr.40-42)

We have carefully conducted a de novo review of the entire record herein and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence, correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings of fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission.

Thus, we affirm and adopt the decision of the Administrative Law Judge, including all findings and conclusions therein, as the decision of the Full Commission on appeal.
